Jesus is the Healer

Dear Friends and Partners,



We were delighted to receive two great teams in June. The first group represented several Omaha Churches and was led by Bib and Bob Shradar from our home Church, Glad Tidings. Joey was thrilled our friends arrived to celebrate his 10th birthday with him on June 8th! (right)



After a one day medical clinic and orphanage visitation in Port-au-Prince, the team arrived to the rural area of Miragoane in Southern Haiti to minister to the people of Chalon by providing daily medical clinics at the Church as well as constructing desks for the school. They also ministered to the children and teachers of the school. The sign above the team picture (above) is the Creole translation for: "Jesus is the Healer" This was the truth the team hoped the people would learn.



To reinforce this principle, while each patient waited, (left) they were visited by a prayer team. (right)



Petit and Cassi prayed for each patient before check in. (left) Besides praying for the patient's health and personal needs, they also shared the gospel. Several people accepted Jesus as Lord! After prayer, vital signs were checked by another team member. Missy checks a girl's blood pressure. (right)



The team had 3 medical providers. Besides caring for general health, they were also able to fit a few patients with donated glasses. Mary confirms the fit for one patient. (left) Heather and Mable did a great job filling prescriptions at the pharmacy. (right)



We were blessed again this year to have Missionary Physician Assistant Ed Amos administer the clinic. Ed added a dental clinic to extract problem teeth. Joanne assists Ed (left) while Joey assists 17 year old Kaneesha who bravely became Ed's understudy.

Some patients were too sick to come to the clinic. Dr. Margie and the prayer team visited this woman dying from cancer. They prayed with her and gave pain medication. (right)
