Book of Hope Haiti Partners are working hard to squeeze in as many school presentations as possible before kids start summer vacation.



As soon as books arrive to our warehouse, they are quickly distributed to children and youth throughout Haiti. (above) In less than 6 months, we have more than doubled the goal we were given by Book of Hope for 2009. In fact, we are almost out of books! Please ask God to provide an additional 525,000 books for us before September 1st so we will be able to continue school distributions when schools re open this fall.

Training for Maximum Impact



With the open door we have in Haiti to visit almost every private and public school, God has impressed us to continually remind our distribution teams they only have one chance to influence the children they stand in front of each day. Therefore, we've invited one of our partners from CEF (*Child Evangelism Fellowship*) to begin a series of half day seminars designed to help team members develop class room presentations that speak to the heart felt needs of kids. During the first seminar, Child Evangelist Vionel Romelus from Cayes, Haiti, (above left standing) challenged 15 of our team members to grow in understanding of how God would have them relate His truths to children and youth in a way they can clearly understand using stories, object lessons, and numerous creative illustrations. Before long, Vionel had the entire group working with paper, scissors, and colored cord to create powerful ministry tools to reach young people! (above right)
