Women Listen to the *Proclaimer*



This summer, the Omaha Glad Tidings team brought 6 *Proclaimer* audio units loaded with the Haitian Creole Bible. We gave 4 to Missionary Jan Thompson. (left center) She and her 3 children are using the boxes in ladies Bible studies (left) and the Gonaives Women's prison. (right) Jan found that most of the ladies in her Ladies Bible study group can't read, so the *Proclaimer* assists her as she shares the scriptures audibly during their lesson times. In the prison, about 25 ladies listen to the scriptures once a week for 30 minutes. Please pray God's Word would penetrate the hearts of these Women's groups as they listen weekly to the *Proclaimer*.
