God's Provision during the Floods

Dear Friends and Partners,



Greetings from Haiti. Many of our "Book of Hope" partners are struggling as a result of back to back Tropical Storms Hanna and Ike. We'd like to share some of their stories and how we were able to respond in a small way to their emergency need. We thank the Lord and you for your generosity.



The water was 8 to 14 feet deep during Hanna and Ike. The above structures are one story houses.



Some people were stranded on the roofs of 2 story houses for many days without food or clean water.

Commanding the Water to Cease

Pastor Maula, his family and many of his neighbors were trapped on the second level of their 3 story YWAM house. They had wept bitterly as they watched people washed away from smaller houses. Finally, when the water was just inches from entering their second level, the group felt faith to pray as Jesus did and take authority over the rising water. They prayed and the water ceased rising!

Escape of the "Gonaives Dozen"



In between storms, Pastor Robert Compere was able to rescue the 12 children from the orphanage he oversees (left) and drive them in his pickup to the capital.



The group arrived in Port-au-Prince two days before the remaining bridges washed out during Ike. We worked with missionaries and Quisqueya Christian School to coordinate hot food and clothing for the children and staff. They will remain in Port-au-Prince until the water recedes from their home in Gonaives.

Rescuing Stranded Kids in Gonaives



Pastor Genada's 28 exhausted orphanage kids (left) were stranded for 2 days on top of their roof and 11 days in two small hotel rooms. They survived drinking flour mixed with water until UN aid arrived. The dry flour was found in submerged sacks. (Turn Over) →
